Outdoor art Enjoy the 25 sculptures using the map and use the website to find out more information about the artists and artworks.

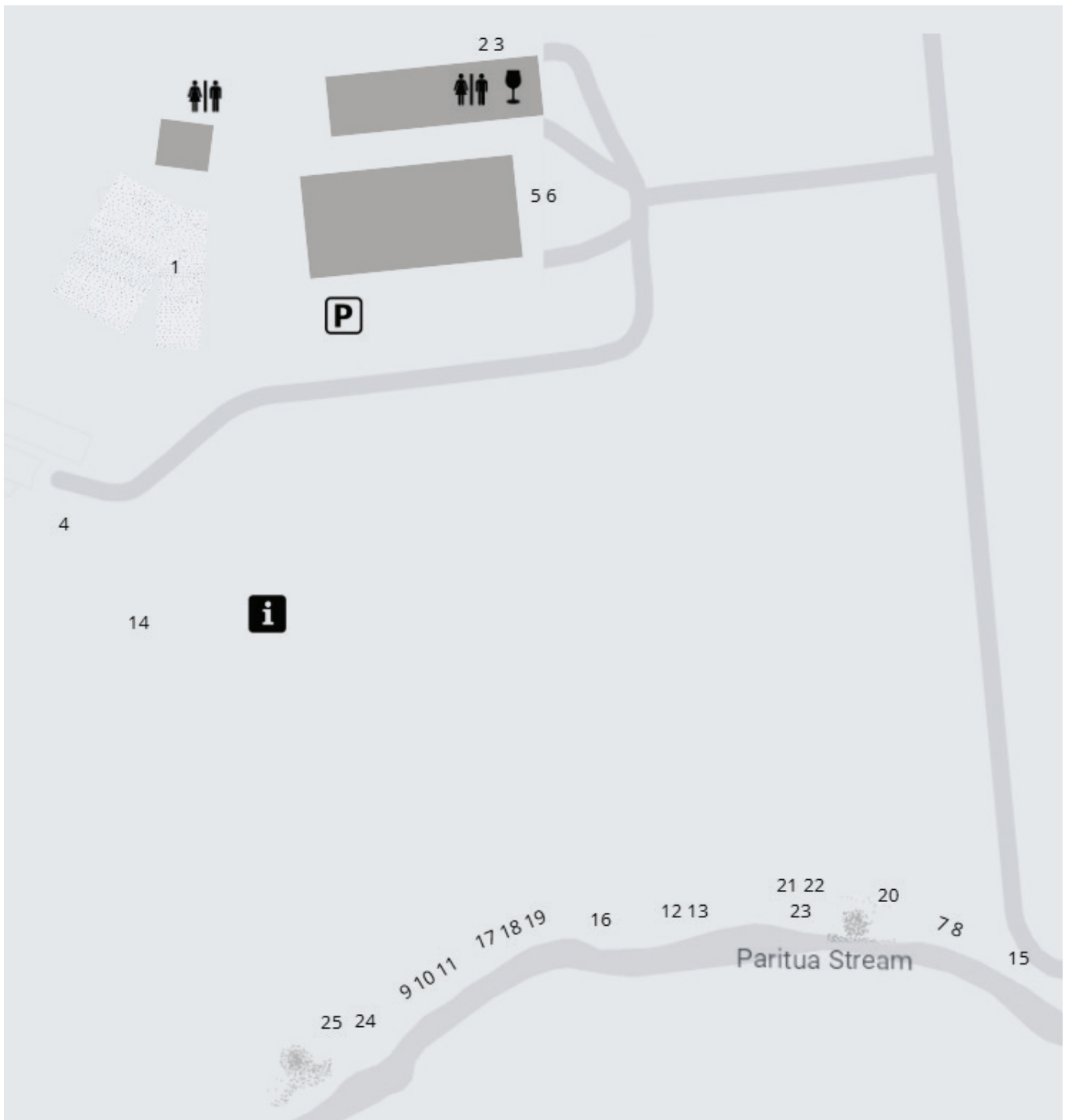
